Five Samoyed Clubs from around the country established the National Samoyed Council (NSC) in the mid 1980's

The objectives of the NSC include:

- to encourage and promote in every way the quality of breeding, care, training and exhibition of the Samoyed;
- to educate and encourage exhibitors, breeders and judges to abide by the Standard for the Samoyed, as approved by Dogs Australia.

Ron Addison is the current President of the NSC and Judy Hughes is the current Secretary.

The first Samoyed National was hosted by the Samoyed Club of Victoria Inc. in 1988. Since then, 4 other clubs have hosted the Show at intervals of around 3-4 years. Each event is eagerly anticipated and is the result of much work from a dedicated team.

The judge for each National is selected by the State hosting the Show and must meet the criteria of having bred, owned and exhibited Samoyeds.

About our Judge Averil Cawthera-Purdy

I have been involved with Samoyeds since girlhood, being brought up with the breed. As a teenager I became the main handler for my family's Lireva Samoyeds and from an early age was involved with our breeding programme and choosing and training the puppies we kept. Ours was always a small hobby kennel with never more than 8 dogs, including our oldies at any one time, more usually around 3 or 4, with litters only being bred when we wished to keep a puppy ourselves.

I started judging the breed in my late teens and also served on the Samoyed Association's Executive Council, the youngest ever member. I was passed by the UK Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed in 1987 and first awarded at Southern Counties Ch Show in June 1987, in my 20s, I still rank as one of the youngest judges of the breed at championship level. I have judged all but one of the Samoyed Breed Club Ch Shows in the UK over the years and also judged at Crufts back in 2007, again becoming the youngest to judge the breed at Crufts, in my 40s.

I have judged in Europe on a number of occasions over the past 30 odd years: Spain, Finland and Italy being the most memorable.

In the ring Lireva Samoyeds have been successful winning 40 CCs and making up 9 UK Chs and winning at Pastoral Group Level.

I am also passed to award CCs in Pomeranians, (my Lireva Poms are the top winning kennel in the UK and have been for many years now.) Alaskan Malamutes and Finnish Spitz. All breeds in which I have owned and campaigned champions. I am also passed to award CCs to German Spitz (Mittel) & (Klein).





If you wish to have your advert to go edge to edge is to have 3mm of bleed on each edge and a 3mm safe zone inside. This means that the length of each side will be 6mm longer. For example an A4 sheet when lined up correctly with bleed will be 216mm x 303mm. It will then be cut down to its finished size of 210mm x 297mm. No image or text is to encroach into a 3mm to 5mm safe zone border 216mm x 303mm. on all sides to avoid being trimmed.

Make sure your advertising copy complies with appropriate standards and legislation. Dogs featured to have only official abbreviations of titles prior to the dog's name.

Only digital advertising can be accepted. For clarity and best reproduction pictures should be at least 300 DPI. and print ready A4 PDF file.

Collection of exhibit numbers and catalogues

Catalogues and welcome bags may be picked up at the Secretary's Office that will be located in the Boxhall Pavilion (see above map).

Set up around the judging ring

Trolleys and grooming tables will not be allowed ringside. Spectator tables will be set up around the ring and there will be an exclusion zone around the ring.

Grooming:

There is no designated grooming area as there is plenty of areas around the pavilion to use. Please note: <u>you</u> are responsible for cleaning up after your grooming area. Dogs Victoria have been extremely generous in cleaning for our area – please don't create extra work for them.

Judging

Conformation judging will take place in the Boxhall Pavillion.

The opening ceremony on day 1 will commence at 8.45am. Judging will commence at the conclusion of the opening ceremony not before 9am. On day 2 judging will commence at 9.00am.

Bitches will be judged on day 1.

Dogs and General Specials will be judged on day 2.

Use of the grounds

Trailer and Vehicle Parking

No trailers or vehicles are permitted on lawn areas throughout KCC Park. This is to protect the lawn and also the below-surface irrigation that has been installed. Parking is available on all gravel and carpark marked areas of the grounds (refer to above map).

Dog Exercise Area

The Park has fenced off-lead areas. There are also barbecues and picnic tables that DOGS Victoria and Companion Dog Club members may use any time the park is **open** (generally 8.30am to 5pm weekdays – weekends if dog events are being held).

Please remember that unless you are in designated, fenced off-leash areas* or are participating in training or competition, your dog must be kept on a lead at all times at KCC Park.

Larger Fenced Area*

The larger fenced area to the south of the Park has for many years been used for lure coursing, followed by herding when that discipline commenced. Clubs representing these activities provided substantial funding, plus manpower, to fence the area, making it more suitable for their sports.

Please note the following:

- If the ground is obviously being set up or used for either lure coursing or herding, the entire area is out of bounds for all other usage.
- If a member is already using the area at any other times, please wait until they leave before entering with your own dogs.
- Please read the conditions of use displayed near the entrances.
- 4. Please pick up after your dogs, using bags and bins provided.
- 5. Please be considerate and give others a turn if they are waiting. We suggest 15 minutes is enough, you may be able to come back later after taking a pleasant lead walk around the rest of the Park and resume your free running.
